**Grace and peace to you from God our Father and from the Lord Jesus Christ.**

In November I had the pleasure of participating in the LWML Prayer Service. It was interesting how the pieces fit together over a Zoom call. It reminded me of the perseverance of St. Paul to continue the work even across the great obstacle of distance between the churches.

Paul used the only technology he had available to him, messengers on foot carrying letters to the churches. It is hard to imagine the time between the writing of the letter until it reached those it was intended to lift up. Then to await a response to the writing that may or may not come. In our day we just log-on to a screen and share what we need to share. Perhaps a day or two goes by before a reply is received. For better or worse we have this technology and an opportunity to share the Word instantaneously.

Paul's perseverance was a little different than what is experienced in the US. He endured violent opposition and great distances between the churches. In other countries Christians do meet with violent opposition. In the case of Finland and other countries in the West the use of prosecution under somewhat arbitrary laws is the process to stifle the church. In all cases the Gospel still proceeds despite the efforts to silence it. It continues to push against the gates of hell.

As we travel through the Advent season, we look to the coming of our Savior as a baby in a manger with immense joy that he endured all to come to our rescue. Persevering even to his death and resurrection in order to defeat death and save his people. We also look to His second coming as conquering King. In Revelation we read, "*And to the angel of the church in Laodicea write: 'The words of the Amen, the faithful and true witness, the beginning of God's creation. 'I know your works: you are neither cold nor hot. Would that you were either cold or hot!' "*" This is certainly the church in general that we see today, lukewarm at best.

Thank God that lukewarm is not a description of the LWML and LCMS. In fact, ladies you are hot with the love of the Lord and it shows in your care for your members, your churches, and missions. The Holy Spirit is truly at work in the LWML lifting you up and those you care for. The sweet message of the Gospel is in everything you do. Continue spreading the message of hope that can only be found in the birth and works of God incarnate, Jesus Christ.

In my daily prayers I am thankful for your ministry and ask that you and all of the brothers and sisters that shepherd the flock may be lifted up, encouraged, and filled with wisdom from our loving God and Savior.

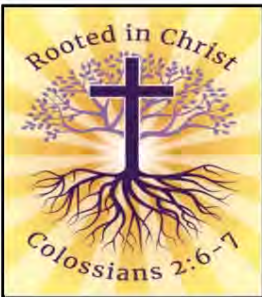

We gathered together at Zion Lutheran Church – Lawrenceville on Oct 14 for our Fall Rally.

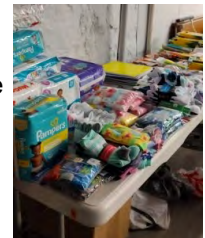
